


Minnow Trap Instructions

(Part No. MT1)




1. Seat ball (A) firmly into ball socket (B) so that the two halves of the minnow trap hinge on each other.
2. For best results, tie bait (C) so it will hang in the center of the trap when it is closed.
3. Place a rock (D) of sufficient weight inside the trap to keep the trap on the bottom.
4. Close the trap by snapping the double-pronged latch (E) into the rectangular catch (F).
5. To lock the trap, insert the clip (G) through the two lip holes (H).
6. To lower or retrieve the minnow trap, tie a cord (I) of sufficient length through the end loop of the clip.
7. Keep the minnow trap openings (J) headed into the current.
8. To open the minnow trap, remove the clip from the two lip holes.
