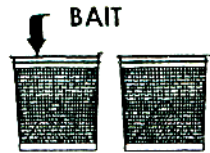
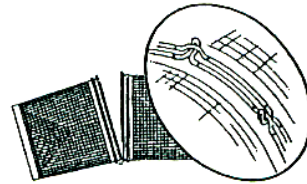


Eel Trap Instructions

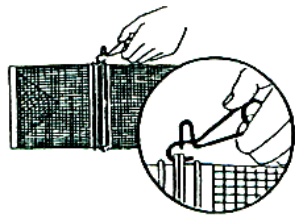

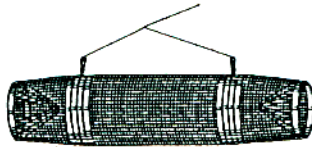
- 1 Bait trap with fish heads, entrails, crushed crabs or other favorite bait.



- 2 Join the two ends and the center section by inserting the wire loops as shown.



- 3 Lock all three parts together by inserting the snap-fastener(s) as shown.



- 4 Fasten a cord or chain securely to the eye of the snap(s). Attach a retrieval cord and place in the water.

Though the trap will catch eels in a few minutes, you will see the best results if you set the trap in the evening (eels are nocturnal feeders). If the trap is properly baited and set in a good location, you will find a day's supply of eels the next morning.



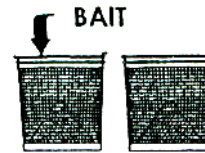
