

Crawfish Trap Instructions (Part No. MT22)




Bait trap with fish heads, entrails, crushed crabs or other favorite bait.



Close trap and lock the halves together by inserting the snapfastener(s) as shown.



Join the two halves by inserting the wire loops as shown.



Fasten a cord or chain securely to the eye of the snap and anchor to the bank or dock. Throw trap into the water so that it runs lengthwise with the current.

You will see the best results if you set the trap in the evening (crawfish are nocturnal feeders). If the trap is properly baited and set in a good location, you will find a day's supply of crawfish the next morning.

Note: To comply with State of Washington Regulation #220-56-320

• Use the G-40-CF 31" Trap—3 sections.



- Secure one end to the center section with a single strand of 100% cotton twine so that the trap will open freely if the twine or fiber is broken. Be sure to change the twine from time to time to prevent the loss of the trap.
- Secure the other end to the center section using the snap provided.




Bait trap with fish heads, entrails, crushed crabs or other favorite bait.



3 Close trap and lock the halves together by inserting the snapfastener(s) as shown.



Join the two halves by inserting the wire loops as shown.

• Use the G-40-CF 31" Trap—3 sections.



- Secure one end to the center section with a single strand of 100% cotton twine so that the trap will open freely if the twine or fiber is broken. Be sure to change the twine from time to time to prevent the loss of the trap.
- Secure the other end to the center section using the snap provided.
