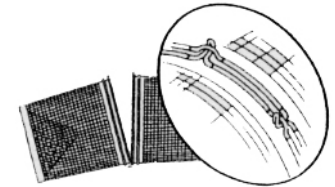
1 Bait trap with dry bread, crackers, dough balls or meat.



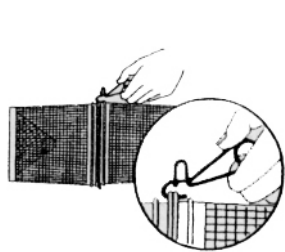
2 Join the two halves by inserting wire loops as shown in the inset.



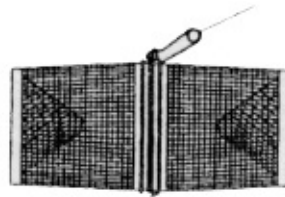

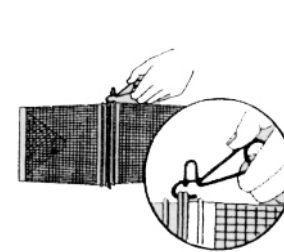

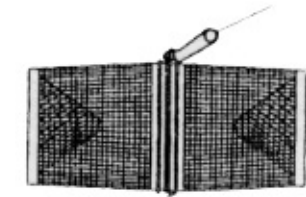
3 Close trap and lock the halves together by inserting the snap fastener as shown.
